Please take note of the information below.

Cap & Gown Distribution/Textbook Return/Item from lockers Disseminated:

May 6th, May 7th, May 8th, and May 11th- 9:00am to 2:00pm

Caps & Gowns (Cafeteria Parking Lot):

On May 6- May 11 from 9:00am to 2:00pm, caps and gowns will be distributed. Within the bag, you will also find any honors paraphernalia, if applicable, that you can wear when taking pictures. Please tape on the passenger window and the back window of your car, a sheet of paper that has the students first and last name and ID#. Please write it large enough to be visible from 6 ft away with a black marker if possible. If you have non-senior students as well, list them on the sign too. Please open your trunk so that we can put the cap and gown bag inside. All individuals are to remain within their vehicle at all times when picking up the students' cap & gown.

Items disseminated from locker (Cafeteria Parking Lot enter from Dixie Highway):

We will clean out all students' lockers. A staff member will place a plastic bag with any locker items that belong to the student within the trunk of your vehicle. Students will only receive items that were found in their assigned locker. If you have other students who attend Bloom, you can pick up their locker contents along with those of your senior.

Textbook return:

Within a plastic bag, please place any textbooks, calculators or school items that are District 206 property. **It is very important that within the bag, there is a sheet of paper with your first and last name, as well as a list of items that are within the bag.** If you have other students who attend Bloom, you will be able to drop off their items as well. Bins/Flatbeds will be provided outside of the breezeway to drop off Bloom items that need to be returned to the school.

Per CDC guidelines, it is very important that we continue to practice social distancing. All individuals are to remain within their vehicle at all times while picking up items.

Once you leave your car, please continue to practice social distancing. We encourage you to wear a mask until your picture is taken. Seniors will walk up to the photo area, take a diploma cover from the table and take your photo. Once your photograph is taken, please pick up a congratulatory yard sign and return to your vehicle. To get to the photo area, all vehicles must enter from Chicago Road and line up on the northside of 10th street.
