

What is Hybrid Learning?

The Hybrid Model of instruction will include both in-person and remote/virtual instruction. Remote/virtual students will receive the same live instruction in real-time as the in-person students are receiving.



Here are a few reminders as we prepare for the hybrid model:

- 1. All students (in-person and remote) will keep their cameras on and log into Google Classroom and Meets using Google Chrome.
- 2. All in-person students must wear their masks covering their nose and mouth at all times.
- 3. In-person students are required to bring their Chromebook every day.
- 4. Parents will be required to complete a daily health screening before their child arrives at school.
- 5. If your child is ill, please keep them at home, as they can participate in class remotely.
- 6. Students will receive a clear book bag upon arrival on the first day they return to school and they will be required to use it when they come to the building. (Students will not have access to lockers or locker rooms and travel to each class with all of their belongings.)
- 7. Students will continue to pick up lunch/breakfast at the bus stops. Walkers who return in person will get a grab-and-go bag as they leave the building.
- 8. Students will be required to wear their IDs.
- 9. There will be no visitors allowed in the building.
